

Local Rules.

1. Markers.

White stakes:	Out of bounds
Red stakes:	Red penalty area
Blue stakes:	Ground under repair
Blue stakes with green top:	Ground under repair and no play zone

2. Stakes are immovable obstructions.

Red and blue stakes on the *course* are immovable obstructions from which a player may take free relief under Rule 16.1. Relief is not allowed to be taken under Rule 15.2.

3. Dropping ball on fairway when original ball is Out of Bounds or lost

According to Model Local Rule E-1 (see the post in the club/webpage), when a ball is out of bounds or lost, the player may drop a ball, with 2 penalty strokes, up to two club-lengths onto the fairway of the hole being played, not nearer the hole from where the ball last crossed the OB boundary or is estimated to have come to rest. ("Fairway" is grass in the general area cut to fairway height or less incl. teeing grounds on the hole.). The local rule does not apply when the ball is in a penalty area, or for the original ball if the player has played a provisional ball from the location of the previous stroke.

4. Newly planted trees.

The young trees identified by net, blue stakes or supporting poles are no play zones: If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree, or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take free relief under Rule 16.1f.

5. Provisional ball for ball in a penalty area

If a player does not know whether the ball is in the penalty area on hole 12 and 13, the player may, contrary to Rule 18.3a, play a provisional ball under one of the three relief options for a penalty area in Rule 17.1d (the provisional ball becomes the ball in play as normal under Rule 18.3).

1. if the original ball is found outside the penalty area, the player shall continue with the original ball
2. if the original ball is not found within 3 minutes search time, or it is known or virtually certain to be in the penalty area, the player shall continue with the provisional ball
3. if the original ball is found in the penalty area within 3 minutes search time, the player can choose to continue with either the original ball or the provisional ball

Penalty for breach of a local rule: General Penalty
